




Infrastructure Funding

- Designated Funds by State Law
- Physical Plant & Equipment Levy PPEL
- State-wide 1 cent Sales Tax

- New Buildings & Improvements
- Building & Land Purchases
- Leases
- School Equipment
- Buses
- Musical Instruments

Infrastructure Funding

- Technology
- Can NOT be used for Teachers
- General Expenses

General Fund

- Allocated Annually by State
- Based on Prior Year Enrollment
- 4% for FY 2014-2015
- Teacher & Staff Salaries
- Utility & Maintenance Expenses
- Can be used for Buildings

General Fund

- Reduced Enrollment
- Reduced Revenues
- Additional Revenues 2014-15, 1%
- Current Spending Levels
 NOT Sustainable
- Reductions are Inevitable

Reduction Options

- Reduce Building Space
- Staffing (80% of General Fund)
 - -Teachers
 - -Administrators
 - -Support Staff
- Three Options

Building Scenario "A"

- Move Manning 3rd & 4th Graders to Irwin
- Move Manilla 5th thru 8th Graders to Manning
- Manning Pre-K & K would remain

Building Scenario "A"

- Move Central Office to Manning
- Close Main Manilla Building & Classroom Wings
- Maintain Gym as Practice Facility
- Use as Central Transportation Hub & Shelter

Building Scenario "A"

- Reduces Utilities
- Consolidates & Reduces Staff \$406,000
- Prevents Future Maintenance Cost of \$ 975,000
- Loss of 1 ICN Room
- Transportation

Building Scenario "B"

- Move K. 1st & 2nd Grades from Irwin to Manning
- Irwin Pre-K Remains
- Manning Pre-K, K 3rd & 4th Grades to Remain
- Manilla 5th 8th Grades Remain

Building Scenario "B"

- Central Office Remains at Manilla
- Opt. B-2, Move Central Office to Irwin
- Close Part of Irwin Building

	
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Building Scenario "B"

- Reduces Utilities
- Consolidates & Reduces Staff \$326,000
- Will Have a Future Maintenance Cost of \$ 975,000
- Transportation

- Move K 1st & 2nd from Irwin to Manning
- Move 5th & 6th Grades from Manilla to Manning
- Move 7th & 8th Grades from Manilla to Irwin

- Close Main Manilla Building & Classroom Wings
- Maintain Gym as Optional Practice Facility
- Use as Central Transportation Hub & Shelter

- Move Central Office to Manning
- Opt. C-2, Move Central Office to Irwin
- Use as Central Transportation Hub & Shelter

- Benefits the Budget


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Recommendation
