

Reconfiguration of Buildings

Hybrid Scenario

- Move 5-6-7 and 8 grades to Manning from Manilla
- Keep 3rd and 4th in Manning
- Move 2 Sections of Kindergarten from Manning to Irwin
- Keep One Preschool in both Manning and Irwin
- Keep All 1st and 2nd Graders in Irwin and Make it A Primary Building with all KG, 1st and 2nd Grades with one Preschool
- Keep the Manilla Gym open for junior high practices (vb and bb) and all junior high basketball games
- Central Office could be located in either Irwin, Manilla or Manning

Pros:

- ❖ Reduced utility cost
- ❖ Reduce shuttles by 3
- ❖ Combining junior high teachers with the high school will increase offerings and will also add periods for three traveling teachers. This amounts to 540 more hours of instruction for either high school or junior high students.
- ❖ Reduces the long term maintenance cost on the Manilla building (roof, lighting, heating and cooling)
- ❖ Reduces the need for added infrastructure cost at Irwin for science, FCS Room, and gym updates
- ❖ As space opens up, classes are moved into those rooms (Manning Site)
- ❖ What funds are saved in the infrastructure cost will be used to upgrade security and intercoms in both Manning and Irwin
- ❖ Utilizes all classroom space in the two buildings

Cons:

- Transporting younger students
- Gym space in Manning
